

# **Capt. Kidd Rod & Gun 22 Shoot Tournament** **Beginning June 13 – 10:00 AM**

**Continuing July, August, September, October, November**

## **Rules:**

- \$ 5.00 registration
  - Tournament will run 6 consecutive shoots
  - Minimum of four rounds/targets per shooter per shoot
  - Each shoot's scores will be averaged
  - All shoot averages will be averaged at the close of the tournament to determine the shooters final score ( average of the 6 shoots)
  - Tournament winner will be determined by the top average score for the duration of the tournament regardless of age class
  - Top score at the end of the tournament will have their name engraved on the trophy and will earn a take home trophy
  - Tournament trophy to remain in the club trophy case for future awarding
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> place scores will receive a take home trophy (one for senior and one for junior)
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> place scores will receive a take home trophy (one for senior and one for junior)
  - Tournament will run from the June shoot to the November shoot
  - Trophies will be awarded at the December shoot
  - In the event of a tie a shoot-off will occur at the December shoot
  - Shoot scores and Final score will be rounded to nearest whole number (NO decimals)
  - Shooters who knowingly fire at another's target will be disqualified from the tournament (NO tolerance)
  - Shooters receiving an extra round in their target will be given the chance to reshoot the target
  - In the event of one shooter receiving an extra round in their target with no clear culprit evident ALL targets from that relay will be disqualified
  - All targets from all registered shooters will be kept for the duration of the tournament for ease of audit in case of disagreement
  - All shooters must fire 22LR firearms and employ club supplied ammunition for the duration of the tournament
  - NO discrimination as to what type of sighting system however only one type of sighting system may be employed at one time
  - Top three shooters at each shoot will receive a token of their achievement
